I would like to emphasize that all the inhabitants of the Baltic States have to think about development and competitiveness of all the Baltic Region. The Local Governments can facilitate in developing the most effective ways of co-operation not only at the level of cities, but on the State Regions scale as well.

Attractive Regions start with attractive cities. For promotion of the whole Baltic Region it is important to have strong Regional centres, strong cities and to develop regional co-operation.

In the conclusion let me wish you very fruitful work in this Congress and I do wish to have strong Local Governments in Estonia and much success in the coming elections of the Local Governments of Estonia.
